## ARKIS MARKS ITS 13TH GRADUATION CEREMONY



# INTERVIEW WITH SAFEYA FAWZI KANOO

**What are the primary motivators that drove the adoption of a cashless business environment at YBA Kanoo?**

We have all been using some form of cashless payments in our operations and daily lives and the technologies have existed with limited adoption. E-commerce organisations including retail and F&B have been practising online payments for a while now being ahead of the trend. The practice of cashless payments in daily operations and lives has existed before the pandemic with limited adaptation.

However, when the COVID-19 pandemic spread across the world, it brought a massive shift to digital payments. Suddenly, all organisations from all different sectors were abruptly prompted to facilitate alternative means to transact and conduct their business, and as a result, we witnessed a spike in the adoption rate of digital payments, reducing cash transactions and almost eliminating cash transactions in some businesses. Adhering to the international norms of transforming into a cashless society, we at YBA Kanoo took this opportunity to become agile and ready to adapt to the times and trends of payments.

With the recent implementation of digital payment tools and processes at the business divisions level in some of the regional footprint we serve, our customers are now able to transact conveniently within seconds through various contactless payment methods;

- QR code payments

The ease of conducting financial transactions is one of the primary motivators to going digital including its convenience, speed and security.

**How will cashless payments benefit the organisation?**

Bahrain, like the other Gulf states, is moving into a digital banking infrastructure, making digital payments the most accessible and convenient way of performing payments for both merchants and individuals. Even when you would go into a small store across the street, the merchant accepts IBAN payments and QR code payments and has a credit card machine. It is a given in the next few years to witness the neo-banking tools and the value they bring will far exceed cash on every level. So it's not a question of "if" but more of a "when" situation.

Simply put, cashless payments benefit the organisation as a whole, complementing the entire ecosystem touching on the end-to-end journey, starting from the customers themselves making payments through to the point of sale and to the back-end finance reconciliation activity. Through digital payments, we are able to make and receive real-time fund transfers, using a seamless secure and trusted end-to-end infrastructure and get accurate transactional data that we can then study to understand the consumer spending trends towards our various business lines.

From the customer's perspective, we have seen that our clients are much more receptive to digital forms of payment. They want to make instant payments and receive an order confirmation instantly, whether they are at a Point-of-Sale or at the convenience of their living room couch.

Giving our clients additional flexibility and convenience in payment methods translates to a streamlined business operation that is directly translated into an increased top-line growth. From a reconciliation standpoint, we are able to clearly monitor and track payments in real-time and identify the source of funds instantaneously. The element of transparency also directly complements our risk and compliance guidelines, making it easier to track and report payments with complete clarity.

**What are the challenges to becoming a cashless economy? Do we have the infrastructure for it?**

This question recalls a famous proverb: "When the winds of change blow, some people build walls, others build windmills". Every disruptive change invites a series of challenges, and more importantly opportunities to identify.

The world has witnessed numerous case studies of companies that have perished as a result of their inability to adapt to the times, trends, patterns and behaviours of the market and consumers.

YBA Kanoo is no exception. That is precisely why we put together a sort of FinTech team within the Group to aid the organisation in raising awareness and making digital payments methods available for our customers and internally assigning project champions, training and supporting the divisions with the implementation, monitoring, and conducting post-implementation analysis and much more. It is a matter of measuring the overall benefits, and seeing the value it brings while also changing the mindsets within our organisation that we are successfully converting pain points into seamless opportunities.

All the GCC countries have established the infrastructure required to become a cashless economy with their up-to-par digital banking infrastructure and cyber security and have been at the forefront of banking innovation for the past few years. As we see the government entities moving fully digital, it encourages us to know that we are moving in the same direction.

A cashless society will deliver transactions that are seamless and accessible to any type of consumer.

## ACCREDITED OPERATOR LICENSE AWARDED TO KANOO LOGISTICS

A special Accredited Operator License was awarded to Kanoo Logistics at a ceremony held by His Excellency President of Customs Shaikh Ahmed bin Hamad Al Khalifa. Kanoo Logistics CEO Yousif Al Manea received the certificate in person from Shaikh Ahmed.

The honouring ceremony was held for selected Logistics and Shipment agencies and companies, where employees were informed of the procedure and necessary steps to be able to transfer shipments from Khalifa bin Salman Port and the Bahrain International Airport in two hours.

The two-hour window, available for commercial shipments, makes Bahrain a pioneer in the region for quick turnaround, and gives Kanoo Logistics the ability to better benefit its clients across the Gulf.

## NESR CONTRACT BUMP

NESR, a Kanoo Logistics customer, were awarded a \$300 million contract from Aramco for conventional fracking. As a result, Kanoo Logistics is now handling the HCL Transportation and Logistics for this awarded contract, with an estimated 120-140 trips per month. Once NESR are at full capacity, Kanoo Logistics will be awarded further work.

Between 20-35 stainless steel ISO Tanks will be rented to NESR for the fracking chemicals. NESR are also challenging Schlumberger for 2023 unconventional business, which, if successful, means Kanoo Logistics will also be able to supply this requirement.



This further cements Kanoo Logistics' position as a Specialised Logistics Provider in Saudi, with extensive knowledge and assets in the ISO Tank business.

## ENHANCEMENT OF TANKS

Kanoo Logistics is upgrading and enhancing its fleet of ISO and Acid Tank Containers. As one of the few suppliers of Acid Tanks in the region, Kanoo Logistics has received ExCom approval to enhance 40 Acid Tanks in two batches. These will be enhanced in both Saudi and Oman, for use in those respective countries with existing clients.

A total of 30 tanks in Saudi and 10 tanks in Oman will

be outfitted with a fibreglass inner shell, as well as a new build of 10 standard T11 Tanks. The full modifications include the fibreglass inner shell, full grating on top of the tank, extra ladders and handrails, modifications on the bottom and airline, and resistant outside painting.





Forklift Operators in Bahrain successfully attended a one-day training on 21st May 2022 for SAFE operations of Forklifts.







Third parties lack cooperation and commitment to compliance; for example, refusing to sign a compliance certification or undergo due diligence.

Third parties have poor business reputation or adverse background such as prior corruptions issues or financial crimes.



Don't hesitate to reach out Compliance should you encounter any red flags or have doubts about such.


